- 1. I hereby confirm receipt of your letter above.
- 2. A query put through our database has revealed that the resident's application for removal of a foreign travel ban has been refused on the recommendation of security officials on May 19, 2015. The refusal contained a brief explanation as follows: "During the months of April and May, you admitted under interrogation that when you were in Qatar with the football team, you carried out actions for the benefit of Hamas, including a mission on behalf of a member of Hamas' oversees headquarters, under instructions from a Hamas activist in Qalqiliya. As part of this mission, you attempted to transfer money and messages from a person of Hamas' oversees headquarters to a representative of the Hamas network in Qalqiliya. In so doing, you have put the security of the Area at risk".
- 3. The resident may submit a new application nine months after making the previous application, i.e. from the day on which the objection was filed.
