Order of Suspension (Temporary Order)

By the power vested in me as the Military Commander and under Section 3 of the Order regarding Suspension of the General Exit Permit (No. 5) (Judea and Samaria) 5751-1991, and under every law and security legislation, I hereby order as follows:

Suspension of Permits	1. Every personal exit permit issued pursuant to Section 3 of the Order regarding Suspension of the General Exit Permit (No. 5) (Judea and Samaria) 5751-1991, or pursuant to the Order regarding Grant of Personal Exit Permits (Judea and Samaria), 5751-1991, prior to the entry into effect of this order is hereby suspended, and anyone who is present in Israel pursuant to the said permit must return to the Area at once.
Entry into Effect and Application	2. The entry into effect of this order is on 9 Nisan, 5753 (31 March 1993) at 03:00 and it shall remain in effect until another order is issued by me.
