Re: <u>Your application to the professional committee for the receipt of a temporary residence</u> <u>visa/stay permit in Israel</u>

- A. The Minister of the Interior, Eliyahu Yishai, at the recommendation of the professional committee (hereinafter: the **committee**) denied your application to receive temporary residence visa in Israel for a special humanitarian reason pursuant to section 3A1(a)(1) of the Citizenship and Entry into Israel Law (Temporary Order), 5763-2003 (hereinafter: the **Law**). The Minister denied the application since he was of the opinion that your application had no special humanitarian reason for the receipt of this status.
- B. The Minister of the Interior, at the recommendation of the committee, decided to give you a stay permit in Israel for a special humanitarian reason pursuant to section 3A1(a)(2) of the Law. The special humanitarian reason for the grant of the permit is the fact that you are the son of your mother who does have status in Israel. You are still single and still tied to your nuclear family.

The permit will be subject to a center-of-life examination, security and Israel Police national headquarters check. If you marry a resident of the Area your status will be revoked.
