HaMoked: Center for the Defence of the Individual, representing the homeowners in reference, has empowered me to make the following communication to you:

- 1. The two homes in reference are located in the village of 'Awarta in the West Bank.
- 2. Several inquiries have been addressed to you in the past with respect to the possible intent to demolish these homes.
- 3. Last night, representatives of the Civil Administration arrived at the homes, asked for information about them and took measurements inside the homes. This has led the families to the understanding that there is, apparently, intent to demolish the homes.
- 4. We therefore wish to inquire whether there is, in fact, intent to demolish the homes. If there is such, we demand that you notify us of same immediately and allow sufficient time to file detailed objections against the intended demolition.

5.	If we do not receive an immediate response, we will consider an urgent petition to the High
	Court of Justice, to ensure the families' right to be heard prior to the demolition is upheld.
