**Re: Closure of the office of the legal advisor at the Erez DCO**

1. Following the implementation of the disengagement plan and the termination of the military administration in the Gaza Strip, we wish to inform you that a decision was made to close the office of the legal advisor at the Erez DCO.
2. Henceforth, individual appeals concerning matters within the scope of the authority of the Erez DCO (such as: permits to enter Israel, travel permits to the Judea and Samaria Area, entry of Israelis to the Gaza Strip, employment in Israel and so forth), must be addressed to the Head of the DCO or to the public appeals officer at the DCO.
3. For legal issues concerning current IDF operations in the Gaza Strip, appeals are to be addressed to the international law division at the Military Advocate General's Office.
